

Privacy Policy

Reid Entities ("Reid") values the privacy of its Web site customers and visitors. This policy describes how Reid Entities collects, uses and safeguards the personal information collected through Reid Entities' Web sites, www.reidentities.com, www.reidtool.com, www.reidsafety.com, www.professionalparts.com, www.tqmachining.com, www.unitedsign.com and their pages ("Sites"):

1. When a customer purchases products or services through the Sites, Reid Entities collects certain personally identifiable information. As a general rule, Reid Entities will not sell, rent or loan personally identifiable information to others for advertising or similar purposes. Reid Entities will only disclose the information as needed to provide requested products or services. This may require Reid Entities to share information with its business partners or affiliates. If you purchase a product through this Site, Reid Entities will have to provide your credit card information to its credit card processor and authenticator for payment purposes. In that case, the credit card number is encrypted as it passes over the Internet.
2. Reid Entities may also disclose personal information in response to law enforcement activity, to enforce its contracts or property rights, or when required by law. Information it collects may also be transferred in connection with the sale or merger of the company or any division or business line of the company to which the information relates. If Reid Entities hires any third-parties to perform services relating to the way the Site functions, it will require them to protect your personal information in the same way that Reid Entities does.
3. Reid Entities may also use different technologies, such as cookies, to collect information passively. The information that it collects might include the type of Web browser that you use, the date and time you visit the Site, your Internet Protocol (IP) address (a unique identifier automatically assigned to your computer when you log onto the Internet), and the address of the web site you visited before coming to this Site. Reid Entities may combine this information with the identifiable information that you provide. This information will usually be used to (i) analyze and monitor consumer and customer activity; (ii) promote and support Reid Entities products and services; and (iii) improve the Sites.
